Safety Recommendation:

The Irish Aviation Authority should review its procedures to monitor the progress of the action taken in response to Safety Recommendations received.

Response:

The IAA advised the AAIU by letter dated 18 July 2016 as follows:

"Please note, the IAA regulator and regulated entity are subject to functional separation pursuant to Article 4 of Regulation (EC) 549/2005 (SES Framework Regulation) and consequently the IAA regulator and IAA regulated entity must be separately and independently responsible for their own actions to address Safety Recommendations.

Herewith an update on actions taken to address this Safety Recommendation in accordance Art 18 of Regulation (EU) No 99612010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 October 2010:

1. The IAA has reviewed its procedures to monitor the progress taken in response to Safety Recommendations addressed to the IAA at both the regulator and service provider (regulated entity) level.
2. Both entities have implemented the functions to monitor the progress of the actions taken on AAIU Safety Recommendations.
3. Related procedures are currently being updated to clarify the respective roles and interfaces as a result of this review.
4. Procedures used by the regulator and regulated entity are subject to separate on-going quality assurance process."

AAIU Comment:

The AAIU consider the status of this safety recommendation as "Implemented, closed"
