**Safety Recommendation:**

The IAA should consider issuing a notice and/or conduct an educational programme for all involved in paramotoring, to stress the importance of operating all equipment within the limitations laid down by the manufacturer.

**Response:**

April 2017

The IAA responded to the AAIU by letter dated 28 April 2017 advising as follows:

"The IAA has reviewed the current policy and proposes the following actions:

- 1) Aeronautical Notice A112 addresses the subject of Flight Permits for single seat aircraft with associated conditions for flight. We will update this notice to add the condition that the aircraft must be operated in accordance with the limitations and conditions provided by the designers and/or manufacturers.
- 2) We will work with GASCI to develop appropriate guidance information to the GA community highlighting the risks of flying aircraft outside of manufacturer recommended limits.

Action 1) should be completed by end May 2017. Action 2) is part of the GASCI action plan and we hope it will be completed within the next three months."
