**Safety Recommendation:**

The Irish Aviation Authority review procedures with regard to the planning and scheduling of calibration flights in Ireland, to ensure that all such activities are subject to Aerodrome and Air Navigation Service Provider Safety Management System processes, particularly where there may be a requirement for proximate calibration by more than one aircraft.

**Response:**

November 2017

The IAA responded to the AAIU on 31 October 2017 advising that:

"During 2013, the IAA Safety Regulation Division (SRD) coordinated with Air Navigation Services Providers (ANSPs) and Aerodromes to ensure that activities related to the planning and scheduling of calibration flights are subject to safety management processes.

Since 2014, as part of the regulatory annual safety oversight programme, the IAA SRD review these procedures to determine if they are being implemented appropriately.

I trust that these actions fulfil the intent of Safety Recommendation IRLD2014014.
